January 2010

- 4 - **Deadline for ALL engineering-based graduate students to submit theses/dissertations in final form for December 2009 degrees (includes Ph.D. students)**
- 18 - Martin Luther King Holiday (No classes)
- 19 - First day of classes
- 22 - **Deadline for unregistered SEAS Masters & D.Sc. students to submit theses/dissertations for format approval (for Spring 2010 graduation) NOTE: Ph.D. students follow GSAS rules and have NO format approval requirement.**
- 25 - Summer 2010 courses begin being posted to Web for viewing
- 25 - First day to file an online Intent for Fall 2010 (open until October 1, 2010)
- 26 - Fall 2009 diplomas available and transcripts begin showing Fall 2009 degrees earned
- 26 - Tuition payment due to Accounts Receivable by 4pm for Spring 2010

February 2010

- 2 - Last day to add, change sections, or waitlist a course for Spring 2010 via WebSTAC until 9:00 p.m.
- 2 - **Last day for ALL unregistered Graduate students to complete ALL degree requirements and submit theses/dissertations in final form (for Spring 2010 graduation --- without having to register for classes and pay tuition charges; any student not meeting deadline must register for spring semester, paying late fees if not registered by end of 2nd week.)**
- 3 - Last day to drop a Spring 2010 course with no notation on permanent record via WebSTAC until 9:00 p.m.
- 4 - All “drops” will be assigned a “W” (i.e. a “withdrawal grade”) from this point forward (up through April 9th)
- 8 - Wait List period ends. All prior wait lists will be deleted.
- 8 - Last day to change Spring 2010 course grade option from Credit/letter-grade option to “P” or “A” (i.e. pass/fail/audit) via WebSTAC until 9:00 p.m.
- 22 - Fall 2010 courses posted to Web for viewing

March 2010

- 8-14 - Spring Break (No classes, Monday thru Sunday)
- 8 - Departments receive reminder note about graduate “final program” paperwork being due at beginning of May
- 8 - Summer/Fall 2010 course listings books tentatively available for A&S students and advisors (the most up-to-date info is always on Web and is available 2 weeks prior to this date)
- 31 - Summer 2010 registration begins

April 2010

- 5 - Engineering advising period begins (approximate timeframe)
- 9 - Last day for Spring 2010 course withdrawals (unless Health Services recommendation)
- 9 - Last day to change Spring 2010 course grade option from Pass/Fail status to “C” option (i.e. “Credit/letter-grade”) via WebSTAC until 9:00 p.m.
- 12 - First day to submit online course evaluations
- 16 - **Deadline for SEAS Masters & D.Sc. students to submit theses/dissertations for format approval for May 2010 graduation. NOTE: Ph.D. students follow GSAS rules and have NO format approval requirement.**
- 20 - Online registration begins for Engineering Graduate students for Fall 2010 courses
- 20 - Online registration begins for Engineering Undergraduates with 90+ earned units (not counting courses currently enrolled in) and undergraduate students doing “study abroad”
- 21 - Online registration begins for Undergrads with 57+ earned units
- 22 - Online registration begins for Undergrads with 24+ earned units
- 23 - Online registration begins for Undergrads with less than 24 earned units to date

May 2010

- 3 - **Deadline for ALL Graduate students to submit theses/dissertations in final form for Spring 2010 graduation (includes Ph.D. students)**
- 3 - Due date for submitting ALL “final program” paperwork for graduating Masters and Doctoral students
- 3 - Last day of Engineering classes for Spring 2010 semester
- 4-5 - Reading period for Engineering students
- 5 - Last day to submit online course evaluations
- 6-12 - Final exam period for Engineering classes
- 13 - Grades due for May 2010 degree candidates
- 14 - Grades due for all Spring 2010 courses
- 21 - Commencement Graduation Ceremony
- 21 - Degree date of May 21, 2010 for Spring/May graduates
- 21 - Transcripts begin printing Spring/May degrees earned
- 21 - First day to file online Intent for SU2010
- 24 - Summer Session I for 2010 begins
- 31 - Memorial Day Holiday (No classes)

June 2010

- 30 - Last day to file “Intent to Graduate” for Summer/August graduates (NOTE: Students must use WebSTAC) (This deadline is typically extended by the Office of Student Records to August 1st.)
