

Tenure-Track Faculty Position in Imaging

We are seeking candidates who have a record of excellence and interest in developing novel imaging technologies. A doctoral degree in engineering, physics, or allied fields is required. Distinguished senior-level applicants are expected to have an outstanding record of educational and research accomplishments. Successful applicants at the junior level will be expected to establish an independent research program with external funding. We expect all successful candidates to also make substantial contributions to teaching at the undergraduate and graduate levels.
